Foreword

Saudi Food and Drug Authority (SFDA) is an independent organization with purpose of regulating and monitoring of foods, drugs and medical devices. One of SFDA functions is to issue national Standards /Technical Regulation in the fields of foods, drugs and medical devices, whether imported or manufactured locally, through specialized technical committees (TCs). SFDA medical devices sector through the work program of technical committee (SFDA/MDS/TC 106) "Dentistry" has adopted the International Standard No. (ISO 20126:2012) "Dentistry -- Manual toothbrushes -- General requirements and test methods", issued by "International Organization for Standardization" in its original language. This standard is adopted identically in its original language and has been approved as a national standard by SFDA CEO decision No (...) on (date).

Scope

This International Standard specifies requirements and test methods for the physical properties of manual toothbrushes in order to promote the safety of these products for their intended use.

This International Standard does not apply to manual interdental brushes and powered oral hygiene devices, as these instruments are covered by separate International Standards.
